### **Safety for pedestrians in atascadero**

- Traffic crossings in atascadero are not safe enough
- People especially young people do not feel safe walking around town
- There needs to be safer ways for students to walk to the middle school or high school
- Our goal is to make atascadero a safer place for people to walk in

#### **Public Outreach**

#### Peers

- Reports of not feeling safe enough while walking down El Camino after 5pm.
- When put on a 1-5 scale of how safe they are feeling while walking the average score was 3.
- More lighting around El Camino.

#### Family

- Hard to see crosswalk from Gas Station to sunken.
- Worry about kids on bikes being struck due to unkept bike lanes.
- Suggested a plan to implement reflective crosswalks.

#### Neighbors

- Expressed concern of Traffic accidents such as the most recent one across from Vons.
- Also mentioned that lack of lighting after sunset.

### Research

- Why is it a problem? As concluded in our Public outreach many residents of town agree that Pedestrian safety is a major concern.
- Who does it affect? This problem is one that goes for everyone. But especially middle schoolers who frequently roam the streets.
- **Is it complicated?** No, improving safety of its Bi Pedal citizens should be the cities main priority.
- What else should the city know? An overwhelming majority of citizens feel unsafe while walking through town.







## **Case Study**

#### San Luis Obispo.

#### Vision Zero.

- What is it? Vision Zero is an idea/non profit campaign that started in Sweden of 1922, the vision aims to eliminate all accidents involving traffic.
- Why it matters? The county of San Luis Obispo has adopted this idea and has reduced reported collisions by 55% as of 2002.
- What was the effect? By partnering with Vision Zero SLO has reduced reported traffic accidents by 55% since 2002.
- How was this Achieved? Through partnering with the Annual Safety Traffic Program the two allow for reports of unsafe pedestrian destinations and strifes to adjust and overcome those hazards.





### **Solutions**

- Properly lit crosswalks for at night
- Have crosswalks painted a more visible color for during the day
- More protected left turns at crosswalks
- Lower speed limit in downtown atascadero
